
American Red Cross Cascades Region

Karl Hausafus was in high school — too young to donate blood himself — when he volunteered to help at a blood drive for the first time. Inspired by his father, who was a lifelong donor, he has since become a routine blood donor and, since his first donation in college, has offered more than *seven gallons* (that's 56 pints!) of his blood to help save lives. Because he is a universal donor (O-negative blood type), his blood is crucial for healthcare workers to have available.

Karl hasn't stopped at giving blood, however. He has organized blood drives nearly every year since around 2007, the most recent being just a month ago at The Liberty Centre where Arnerich Massena's office is. Now, he has joined the Board of the American Red Cross Cascades Region, elevating his lifelong passion and dedication into a new level of service.

The American Red Cross is known for its life-saving blood donation work, but Karl emphasizes that it does much more. The Red Cross provides disaster services, safety & preparedness training, shelter assistance, and even installs free smoke alarms. The Cascades Region chapter serves 42 counties in Oregon and Southwest Washington, providing services for almost 5 million people. They respond to both large and small emergencies, including home fires, wildfires, storms, earthquakes, floods, and more, with volunteers ready to help organize shelter, provide emergency care, and help victims access important resources.

As a member of the Board, Karl will participate as part of the organization's emergency response and disaster recovery teams, assisting with local emergencies but also being available for national disaster response efforts. He will continue to promote blood drives and other important emergency preparedness initiatives.
