The history of PWIM

Portland Women in Investment Management (PWIM) was founded in 2013 by a group of women investment professionals — including Arnerich Massena alumna Terri Schwartz, along with Rhoni Wiswall, Christine Scheider, and Jeanine McAninch — as an informal organization for women active in the investment industry in the Portland area to network and learn from one another. Just last year, it became a registered non-profit, making its board and charter official. After years of offering fellowship, camaraderie, and mentorship to local-area female financial professionals, the organization is setting itself up with a formal structure to extend its mission into the future.

What does PWIM do?

PWIM's mission is to build a community that will serve women in financial services, providing support, mentorship, and education to facilitate collaboration and career growth. The organization hosts quarterly events for members that feature speakers on topics of interest such as career development, economic updates, and experts on financial and investment topics. Every meeting promises something inspirational, informative, and interesting.

In addition to formal quarterly events, PWIM brings members together to network at happy hours, experience-based cohort events, and holiday gatherings. PWIM also hosts volunteer events, providing members with the opportunity to contribute to the community, and to use their numbers to make a difference.

PWIM is also dedicated to helping members further their careers in financial services. The organization organizes mentorship opportunities, matching experienced members with newer entrants to the industry to provide expertise, guidance, and ideas. An entrepreneurship group helps female entrepreneurs launch their ideas. And the group shares notifications of job openings and opportunities in the industry.
