He has focused most of his career on ways to connect investment with natural resource conservation, helping investors participate in the development of water, farm, and renewable energy projects. The Freshwater Trust (TFT) was founded in 1983 to design and implement data-driven, science-based solutions to ensure the resilience of freshwater resources in the Pacific Northwest. The organization focuses on strategically restoring major river basins throughout Oregon - including the Rogue, Sandy, Deschutes, Grande Ronde, and McKenzie Rivers — and also in Idaho and California. They work on the ground with projects like planting trees, creating log jams, increasing streamflow and water quality, and restoring habitats,



whom are passionate about TFT's work and goals. In a previous life, Ryland worked for The Freshwater Trust; he was charged with building relationships with stakeholders in the river basins of Oregon and working to acquire water rights and develop creative water conservation strategies to increase streamflow for fish in a collaborative, non-litigious way that he calls "free-market conservation." His background is deeply valuable in his service as a member of The Headwaters Council.

TFT's recent projects include fire recovery and resilience action after the historic wildfires in Southern Oregon, habitat restoration in the Sandy River basin, and restoring groundwater in the Sacramento-San Joaquin basin. TFT works with precision analytics and technology to assess where their efforts will have maximum impact for the least dollars.
