## The Hopscotch Foundation Named Outstanding Philanthropic Foundation 2020



The Hopscotch Foundation, founded by Dave Gunderson, was launched to help improve the nutrition for at-risk youth in low-income areas of Portland. But during the COVID-19 pandemic, the organization has become a critical source of food for local students and families suffering from food insecurity. The all-volunteer team went to work and used its existing infrastructure to begin delivering food to more than 18 local schools, serving thousands of students and their families weekly. Not only do they provide food, but it is fresh, nutritious, and much of it locally sourced.

During the spring of 2020, Arnerich Massena partnered with The Hopscotch Foundation to help provide much-needed nourishment to the students of the company's *I AM Learning Partnership*, many of whom previously relied on school-provided lunches for nutrition. Working with Dave and Hopscotch and recognizing the incredible need they were facing due to the pandemic's impact on food insecurity, the firm launched FEED PDX, a fundraising drive to help expand the reach of The Hopscotch Foundation. Together, we raised more than \$50,000, making it possible for Hopscotch to feed thousands more children.
