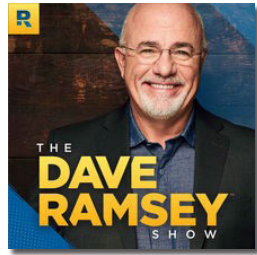

Freakonomics

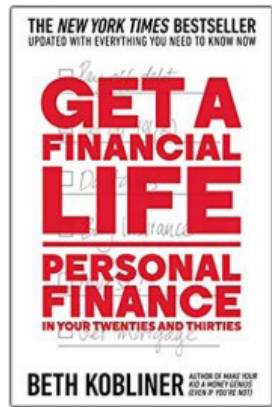

The Dave Ramsey Show

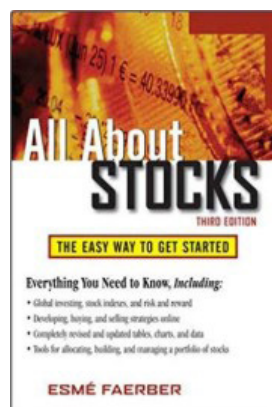

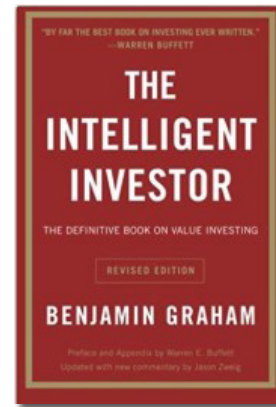

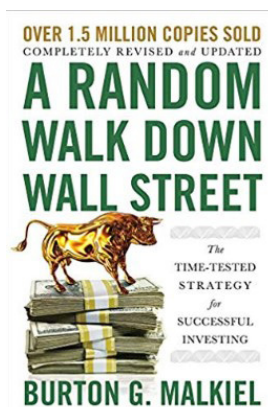
